#### RESEARCH FOCUS

Long-term research focus is on the evolutionary relationships of vascular plants, particularly of the taxa of the families Brassicaceae and Asteraceae. Among them, attention is paid especially to the evolution of polyploid complexes using wide spectrum of methodical approaches (karyology, multivariate morphometrics, molecular methods, distribution, nomenclature). From among molecular methods fragment analyses, Sanger as well and Next Generation Sequencing were used. Biodiversity informatics is other important research subject comprising work on checklists of vascular plants for Slovakia and for selected plant families also on European level, as well as digitalisation of biodiversity collections.
